The journey of Sacred Heart Convent School began when with immense faith; the dedicated sacred heart sisters rented the ground floor of the sath Niwas at Kolgaon and open the Kindergarten section on 16th June 2016 without much fanfare.

But Academic year 2017-18 the school has opened its primary section up to Std III and housed almost 69 students under two shifts in the same place. As a result in response to the growing need of the time with god’s grace and divine intervention, the construction of the proposed school building started on 13th October 2017.

Blessing and Inauguration of New School Building.

“Don’t be pushed by your problems: be led by your dreams “It was indeed a day to rejoice as our dream of having a new spacious building for the school turned in to a reality on 14th June 2018 in spite of all the difficulties and strain. The blessing and inaugural function of the school building is one of the most important days in the annals of sacred heart. On 14th June 2018, His Excellency Mar Thomas Elavanal the Bishop of Kalyan diocese blessed the building and Rev. Sr. Joyce Liza , the General Councilor of Sacred Heart Congregation inaugurated the building by cutting the ribbon. The school campus was filled with the presence of Rev, fathers and sisters and other invited dignitaries parents and students. A cultural programme was put up by the students to mark this occasion.

School permission and Recognition.

The School management has received the permission to open a school under CBSE Board on 15th February 2018 from the ministry of Education, Mantralaya at the hands of Honorable Minister Mr. Vinod Tawade. With a grateful mind we acknowledge his selfless support. Mr. Mahesh Zagade the divisional commissioner of Nasik, guided to clear all the legal formalities to get the permission in time . On

3rd March 2018 with the divine intervention the school has received the Irat Patru or the recognition letter from the Director of Education, Pune through Mr. Ramachandra Jadhav, The Deputy director of Nashik. The School has also received its Pratam Manyata or recognition letter on 17th May 2018 from Mr Ramakant Kathumare the Deputy education officer , Zillaparishad, Ahmednagar. In fact, school management has completed almost all the process to run the school at Kolgaon.

Beginning of New Academic Session.

The Academic year 2018 commenced on 18th June with a special prayer. During the assembly our beloved principal introduced and explained the theme of the year. "Be educated to educate .
