Sub :- Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule (4) of 11 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009.

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 24/06/2025 and subsequent correspondence with school / inspection in this regard, I Mr. BHASKAR PATIL District Education Officer (Primary), Zilla Parishad, Ahilyanagar convey the grant for provisional recognition to the Sacred Heart Convent School, At/p- Kolgaon for Class 1 to 8 for a period of three years w.e.f. 1/4/2025 to 31/3/2028.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions: -

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize or affiliate beyond Class VIII.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure II).
3. The school shall give admission in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the 'neighbourhood and provide to them free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of pre-primary classes also, this form shall be followed.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The society/school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission: to any child for lack of age proof. On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. (Seven) The school shall ensure:
 - 1) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in the school.
 - 2) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - 3) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - 4) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23
 - 5) Students with disabilities/special needs are included as per provision of the Act
 - 6) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 5 years.
 - 7) The teacher performs his or her duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act.
8. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
9. The school shall enroll students proportionate to the faculties available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.
10. The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under: -

11. No unrecognized classes or divisions shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
 12. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
 13. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or the Bombay Public Trusts Act 1950.
 14. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person or for any other profit.
 15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules, a copy each, of Statements of Accounts should be sent to the DEO every year.
 16. The recognition Code Number allotted to your

The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the Government or Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
 18. Renewal of Registration of Society if any is ensured.
 19. Other conditions as per Annexure 'III' enclosed.
 20. The institution shall complete all pending inadequacies to the office of Hon. Charity Commissioner regarding registration, incumbent change report, renewal, audit, etc. The school shall preserve the updated copy of Annexure 1 from Hon. Charity Commissioner to the school record.
 21. If there is a dispute in the organization, the authorities determined and finalized in Appendix 1 by the charity commissioner, Ahmednagar or it will be given to the administrator appointed on the school of this organization by Hon. Charity commissioner.
 22. The rules, circulars, orders and procedures issued by the government from time to time are binding on both the society and school. The organization/school strictly adheres to the rules, circulars, orders and procedures issued by the government from time to time.
 23. It is mandatory to the Self-financed Schools to comply with the provisions of the Maharashtra Self-financed School (Establishment and Regulation Act 2012 (01 of 2013).
 24. The government grants permission to start an English Medium school at, Kolgaon with the name Sacred Heart Convent School (CBSE) There will be no change in medium and location in future. If the society/school makes any change in it, the recognition will be deemed to be revoked automatically and the school will be deemed unauthorized from the very date.
 25. It will be the responsibility of the concerned school to obtain UDISE number from the competent authority.
 26. Incorporating the information of every student enrolled in the school in SARAL system, updating, linking the Aadhaar, submitting UDISE information to the concerned authority in the prescribed time frame and format, taking all necessary actions under 'Pragat Shaikashanik Maharashtra Scheme' etc. will be the responsibility of the school.
