

3. If a pupil is likely to be absent through illness for more than a week, the Principal must be informed at once.
4. Any communication (request or complaint) made by the parents should be addressed to the principal and not to the class teacher and all correspondence from the school to the parents or guardians must go through the Principal.
5. Parents, Guardians, Ex-students and Visitors are forbidden to go to the classes to see the students or interview their teachers during school hours, without the permission of the Principal.
6. There will be "Open House" on Saturday following the unit test and terminal examination, where parents / guardians are free to meet the class teacher, concerning the performance of their child and discuss the papers. Papers will not be sent home or shown any other day.
7. Parents are given to understand that they cannot dictate the Management, but that the Management has a right to say on what conditions it will admit or retain pupils.
9. Criticism of your children's teachers or school in their presence should be studiously avoided, because it causes them to lose respect for their teachers with consequent failure to learn from the teacher. If you have a legitimate complaint, please see the principal early.
10. Withdrawal of your children from class for mere social function is not recommended because it retards their progress in school and minimises their respect for regular hard work, with consequent failure to progress in studies.
11. As the medium of instruction is English, children should be helped to follow their classes easily and intelligently by getting them to speak in English with their classmates and companions at home.
12. Parents or tiffin carriers should not enter the school building during the lunch break.
13. Enrolment in the school implies on the part of the student and parent / guardians to comply with the requirements and regulations of the school.

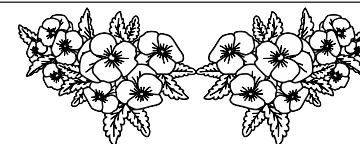
